Preface

Learn and Grow is aimed at Year 6 Basic Education students. It exposes young learners to seven learning units, each of which includes up-to-date thematic concerns that cover SMART (specific, measurable, achievable, realistic, and time-bound) learning objectives. I- Kiss on the cheek

2- Shake hands

Cambodia, India, and Japan An Indian, a Cambodian, and a Japanese usually bow to greet people.
